ORDER OF THE BOARD (by I. Goodman):

The Petition for Variance filed October 9, 1980 is dismissed. The rule in question, Rule 203(g)(1)(B) of Chapter 2 (Air Pollution Control) does not exist as a state regulation. The substance of the rule does, however, exist as part of the SIP under \$110 of the Clean Air Act. The relief Petitioner seeks can be sought via an operating permit application to the Agency. Such permit, if acceptable as a SIP revision, will insulate Petitioner from enforcement actions pursuant to the SIP.
