

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On November 1, 2001, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Vandalia C.U.S.D. (Vandalia) may appeal a September 26, 2001 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency regarding a high priority corrective action plan and budget. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). Vandalia's facility is located in Fayette County. The Board extends the appeal period until January 29, 2002, at the parties' request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Vandalia fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
