NEW PROPOSED ILLINOIS STREAM
PROTECTION RULES NEEDS YOUR HELP!

Governor Ryan's administration is proposing to Pollution Control Board plug a loophole in Illinois' clean water program – the lack of an effective "antidegradation" policy. This policy prohibits the lowering of water quality on streams meeting standards and allows the designation of discharge-free "outstanding water" areas.

The state's biggest polluters are preparing major challenges to this proposal, to be debated before the Illinois Pollution Control Board (IPCB).
