## ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD July 24, 1980

CITY OF MORRIS, Petitioner, PCB 80-73 v. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, Respondent.

INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

The variance requested in the petition in this case was originally requested by the City of Morris in a petition dated January 16, 1980 docketed as PCB 80-11. The Board entered a final order in PCB 80-11 on April 3, 1980. The variance was denied on the basis of the petition and the Agency's Recommendation, as hearing was waived.

On April 15, 1980 Morris filed its first petition in PCB 80-73. On April 17, 1980 the Board ordered Morris to amend its petition to "specifically request or waive a hearing" as required by Procedural Rule 401(a)." The amendment filed by Morris on May 15, 1980 did not make this specific request or waiver.

On May 29, 1980 the Board ordered Morris to "unequivocally request or waive a hearing." Morris has filed nothing in response to this latest Order.

Morris was twice warned that failure to amend its petition as requested by the Board would make it subject to dismissal.

This petition is hereby dismissed.
