ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On March 12, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Strong Oil Company (Strong) may appeal a February 15, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency denied reimbursement for certain corrective action costs regarding Strong's facility at 144 South Congress Street, Rushville, Schuyler County. Since the parties do not indicate the date of service on the petitioner, the Board will calculate the extension from the date of the Agency determination. The Board extends the appeal period until June 20, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Strong fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
