ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M. McFawn):

This matter is before the Board on two motions filed by petitioner Clarendon Hills Bridal Center on March 23, 1995: a motion for reconsideration, and a motion to extend time in which to file a brief in support of petitioner's motion for reconsideration. Petitioner seeks reconsideration of the Board's February 16, 1995 opinion and order in this case, which affirmed in part and reversed in part the Agency's denial of reimbursement from the Illinois Leaking Underground Storage Tank Fund of certain costs in connection with petitioner's removal of underground storage tanks.

In its motion for extension of time, petitioner seeks an additional 14 days to file a brief in support of its motion for reconsideration. Petitioner states that the record in this case consists of six volumes and almost 1,000 pages of testimony which must be reviewed. Additionally, one of the attorneys who handled this case is leaving the firm representing petitioner, and other attorneys must familiarize themselves with the case.

The motion for extension of time in which to file a brief in support of petitioner's motion for reconsideration is hereby granted. Petitioner's brief must be filed on or before April 13, 1995.
