Opinion of the Board (by Mr. Currie):

The City operates a power plant for which an approved Air Contaminant Emission Reduction Program (Acerp) required replacement of coal-fired boilers with oil-gas units by July 1, 1971. Because of delivery delays the City requested an extension to October 1. That date is tomorrow, and by then this petition will be moot. National Gypsum Co. v. EPA, # 71-99 (August 2, 1971).

Within the past few days, however, the City has filed an additional petition asking for an extension to January 1, 1972 because of operating problems with the new equipment being installed. We shall await the Agency's recommendation and decide the case without hearing.

The earlier petition # 71-181 is dismissed as moot.
