This matter is before the Board on respondent the Village of Hampshire's October 17, 1994 motion to supplement the record on appeal. Petitioner Solvent Systems International, Inc. (Solvent Systems) has not filed a response to the motion.

The Village seeks to supplement the record with a certified copy of its Ordinance 91-1 "An Ordinance to Provide for Reimbursement of Certain Engineering and Attorney's Fees Related to Building, Zoning, Annexation, Subdivision, and Related Matters". The Village contends that Ordinance 91-1, which was in effect during the siting review process at issue in this case, is such an ordinance.
