On December 10, 1979 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a motion to dismiss this proceeding. On December 11, 1979 the City of Chicago also filed a motion to dismiss. Both motions were based upon the fact that the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois in <u>Pollution Control Board v</u>. <u>Illinois State Chamber of Commerce, et al.</u>, Docket No. 51671, found that Rule 203(g)(1)(A) of the Board's Air Pollution Regulations was invalid. As the variance sought by the City of Chicago requests a variance from only Rule 203(g)(1)(A), the petition is hereby dismissed as moot.
