On June 1, 1994, Robert J. Sheehy & Sons Funeral Home (Sheehy) filed a petition for review of an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) final reimbursement determination from the Underground Storage Tank Fund. The Agency issued a final reimbursement decision on April 1, 1994, accompanied by Attachment A which contains the stated reasons for deductions.
