ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C. A. Manning):

On September 1,1993, Safety-Kleen filed a status report in accordance with the Board's order of June 17, 1993. The report states that on December 11, 1992, the parties to this appeal met to discuss a resolution of the issues underlying the abovecaptioned matter. During that meeting, the parties developed a mutually acceptable concept as to how to proceed to resolve the appeal issues. The report notes that over the past several months, the parties have reduced these conceptual understandings to agree to language in four other closure appeals involving Safety-Kleen facilities, and each of these appeals has been voluntarily dismissed. Safety-Kleen advises that the parties have now focused their attention on resolving the instant appeal in the same manner. Safety-Kleen states that it believes that this appeal can be resolved within the next forty-five days and will file further status reports to keep the Board and hearing officer apprised of the status.

The parties are directed to file an updated status report on or before October 15, 1993.
