
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade) :

On December 4, 1992, the School District filed a status report with the Board. The status report indicates the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) has agreed to register four underground storage tanks (USTs) located at Kimball High School but continues to object to the registration of five other tanks that were previously removed. On September 11, 1992, the Circuit Court granted the School District's Motion for Summary Judgment and directed OSFM to register the five USTs. On November 23, 1992, the OSFM filed a Notice of Appeal to the Appellate Court of Illinois First Judicial District and on November 24, 1992, the OSFM filed a Motion to Stay Enforcement of Judgment Pending Appeal. A hearing on this motion was scheduled for December 14, 1992.

To assure that this matter before the Board is handled as expeditiously as possible, the School District is instructed to inform the Board promptly of any changes in the current status of these proceedings. The School District is directed to continue to submit quarterly status reports. The next status report is to be filed with the Board on or before March 1, 1993.
