ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. C. Marlin):

On December 17, 1992, the Board issued an order directing the parties in this case to file a status report on or before December 31, 1992. At that time, a status report was due in this case and was 61 days late. On December 30, 1992, the Board received a status report from Safety-Kleen in this matter. Safety-Kleen states that it is willing to file another status report with the Board in thirty days. Accordingly, the Board orders Safety-Kleen to file its next status report on or before February 8, 1993.
