
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R.C. Flemal):

This docket was opened on October 24, 1991 by the Board in anticipation of modification of the geographic boundary of the Metro-East ozone nonattainment area by the United States Environmental Protection (USEPA) pursuant to Title I of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990. Such modification would also have required amendment of those portions of the Board's reasonably available control technology (RACT) regulations that define the Metro-East ozone nonattainment area for the purposes of Illinois' regulations. However, the Metro-East area was not modified in USEPA's most recent nonattainment designations<sup>1</sup>, and no other modification of the Metro-East nonattainment area now appears imminent.

For the foregoing reason, the Board hereby dismisses this proceeding.
