ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

On December 21, 1992, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed a motion requesting the Board to grant it additional time, until January 29, 1993, to respond to Navistar International Transportation Corporation's and the Engine Manufacturers Association's (petitioners) second amended petition.
