On September 1, 1992, A.B.Dick Company (A.B. Dick) filed a motion requesting the Board to supplement the record in this matter with the following three documents:


1. Letter from Mr. James Kurtz of A.B. Dick to Mr. Charles A. Zeal, IEPA Permit Section, dated September 13, 1991, which summarized the meeting of September 5, 1991 between representative of IEPA (including the Leaking UST Section) and representatives of A.B.Dick;
2. Letter from Mr. James Kurtz of A.B. Dick to Ms. Betty Lockart, IEPA Leaking UST Section, dated April 9, 1992, and transmitting A.B. Dick's "20 Day Report"; and
3. Letter from Mr. James Kurtz of A.B. Dick to Ms. Betty Lockart, IEPA Laking UST Section, dated May 22, 1992, and transmitting A.B. dick's "45 day report".

In support of its motion, A.B. Dick states that the above-listed correspondence is relevant to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) denial of reimbursement. A.B. Dick also asserts that the Agency has no objection to including the documents in the Agency record.

The Board hereby grants A.B. Dick's motion.
