ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R. C. Flemal):

This matter comes before the Board on a motion to further extend the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (Agency) response date¹ filed by the Agency on March 4, 1992. Section 106.714 of the Board's procedural rules provides that an Agency response to a petition for adjusted standard is due 30 days after the filing of the petition. The Agency states that Illinois-American Water Company (Water Company) has no objection to the extension. Water Company has previously filed a waiver of time for the Board to render its decision in this matter.

The Board grants the Agency's motion to the extent that a response is now due no later than May 28, 1992 (120 days from the original due date of January 30, 1992)
