
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 28, 2000, complainant and respondents filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement, accompanied by a motion requesting relief from the hearing requirement pursuant to Section 31(c)(2) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(2) (1998)). The proposed stipulation would settle both the complainants' complaint against both respondents as well as the cross-complaint filed by the Estate of Lloyd Wiemann against Cheryl Halbrooks. The Board directs the Clerk of the Board to cause publication of the required newspaper notice for the stipulation and proposal for settlement and request for relief from hearing.

Unless the Board determines that a hearing is needed, the Board is required to cause notice of the stipulation and proposal for settlement and request for relief. Any person may file a written demand for hearing within 21 days after receiving the notice. If a hearing is requested, the Board will accordingly deny the parties' request for relief and schedule a hearing.
