

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

On December 12, 1991, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") filed a motion asking the Board to grant it extension of time, until April 1, 1992, in which to file its recommendation. This is the Agency's second motion for extension. In support of its motion, the Agency states that Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Company ("3M") is currently involved in negotiating its appeal of the Federal Implementation Plan with USEPA and that the negotiations "may impact the desirability of the requested variance from the Agency's perspective." The Agency asserts that Minnesota Mining and Manufacturing Company has no objection to the motion. The Board hereby grants the motion.
