

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. C. Marlin):

On October 10, 1991, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency filed a Motion to Extend Time in Which to File Agency's Recommendation. The Agency asks that the Board extend the time "until such time as Petitioner, M&D Flexographic Printers, Inc. and the USEPA have resolved the issues lying between them". The Board grants the motion in part, in that the Board will extend the time for filing of the recommendation for 120 days from this date. The Board further directs the Agency and the Petitioner to file a status report on this proceeding with the Board no later than January 23, 1992, at that time the Agency may renew its motion for extension of time.
