In SB 1771, P.A. 85-1145, effective July 29, 1988, the General Assembly approved the transfer of certain submerged land beneath Lake Michigan to Loyola University. Loyola has submitted applications for necessary permits for a "lakefill" project with the Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). Given the degree of public interest in this matter, IDOT and the Corps are holding a joint public hearing. The Board, with the concurrence of the Chairman, appoints as its hearing officer in this matter Mr. Richard Christopher, of the IDOT Office of Chief Counsel.
