Anchor Glass Container Corporation ("Anchor") filed a July 22, 1988 petition for review of an air permit denial. With this petition, but filed separately, was an exhibit, entitled "Gurnee Furnace No. 2 Comparison of 1978 Batch With Current Formula to Verify No Material Changes Have Been Made," together with an "Application for Nondisclosure," filed on that same date.
