On March 28, 1988 the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) filed its Agency Request To Withdraw Regulatory Proposal, which sought the withdrawal of its proposal to amend the regulations and the termination of this proceeding.

The original proposal was filed on September 19, 1983 and merit hearings were conducted on January 17 and 31, 1984. Hearings on the economic impact study filed by the Department of Energy and Natural Resources were held on May 14 and June 30, 1986.

The Motion further states that significant portions of the proposal have been or will be superseded by statewide proposals, which reflect a more comprehensive approach to regulatory revisions.

The Board accepts Petitioner's Motion and for the foregoing reasons grants the Motion: This Docket is dismissed.
