ORDER OF THE BOARD (by S.T. Lawton, Jr.):


On October 19, 2000, Midwest Illinois Restaurant & Truck Plaza, Inc. (Midwest) filed a petition for review of an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) determination regarding Midwest’s August 2000 Amended Corrective Action Plan and Budget for its facility located at Interstate 70 and Route 127, Greenville, Bond County, Illinois. The Board accepts this matter for hearing.

The Board’s rules require that the Agency file the entire Agency record of the corrective action plan within 14 days of notice of the petition. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.102. Hearing must be scheduled and completed in a timely manner, pursuant to the applicable statutory decision deadline, or the deadline as extended by waiver. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code. 101.105.

Absent any future waivers of the decision deadline, the statutory decision deadline is now February 16, 2001 (120 days from October 19, 2000); the Board meeting immediately preceding the decision deadline is scheduled for February 15, 2001.
