ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board based upon Petitioner's August 13, 1987 "Notice of Appeal of Adverse Decision". Petitioner seeks a hearing to contest the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's denial of a permit. However, the Board finds Petitioner's petition deficient as follows:

- 1) Failure to identify the particular standards under which a permit is sought. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- 2) Failure to provide a complete and precise description of the facility or equipment for which a permit is sought, including location. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- 3) Failure to provide a complete description of contaminant emissions and of proposed methods for their control. 35 Ill. Adm. Code Section 105.102(a).
- 4) Failure to provide other such materials which demonstrate compliance with the Act and regulations.
- 5) Proof of service of the Petition upon the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Unless an Amended Petition curing the above noted defects is filed within 45 days, this matter will be dismissed.
