ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 10, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Ampco Pittsburgh Corporation (Ampco) may appeal a May 15, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency modified Ampco's corrective action plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at former Wyckoff Steel, 3200 South Kedzie Avenue, Chicago, Cook County. The Board extends the appeal period until September 17, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Ampco fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
