## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On July 2, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (Authority) may appeal a May 24, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of the Authority's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at Mile Post 109 of the East-West Tollway (I-88), DeKalb, DeKalb County. The Board extends the appeal period until October 1, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If the Authority fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
