IN THE MATTER OF: NEW SOURCE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS: INDUSTRIAL - COMMERCIAL -INSTITUTIONAL GENERATING UNITS (35 ILL. ADM. CODE 230.142)

RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Theodore Meyer):

This matter comes before the Board upon a November 25, 1986 notice (51 Fed. Reg. 42768) published by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) of the promulgation of an amendment to the National Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources (NSPS):

> Subpart D: Industrial - Commercial -Institutional Steam Generating Units 40 CFR 60 Subpart Db (35 Ill. Adm. Code 230.142)

Pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Environmental Protection Act, the Board is required to adopt amendments "in substance identical" to the federal NSPS amendments. The Board will do so through incorporation by reference of the federal amendment as a peremptory amendment.

ORDER

The Board hereby adopts the following amendments to Title 35: Environmental Protection; Subtitle B: Air Pollution; Chapter I: Pollution Control Board; Part 230: New Source Performance Standards:

SUBPART D: STEAM GENERATORS

Section 230.142 Industrial - Commercial - Institutional Steam Generating Units for which Construction is Commenced after June 19, 1984

The Board incorporates by reference 40 CFR 60, Subpart Db as adopted at 51 Fed. Reg. 42768, November 25, 1986.
