The letter noted that the specified documents "include Sours Grain federal and state income tax return from its latest fiscal year."

The Board directs Sours attention to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.107(c),(1),(2) and (3): in order for the Board to consider Sours' request, Sours must address those provisions with specificity. Therefore, the Board orders Sours to submit a application for nondisclosure responsive to those provisions no later than December 29, 1986. In the interim, the Board will maintain the financial information as confidential.
