On May 2, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until July 28, 2002, the time period within which Smithfield Properties IV, L.L.C. (Smithfield) may appeal a March 20, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency rejected the corrective action completion report regarding a leaking underground storage tank at 222 South Racine Avenue, Chicago, Cook County. Because Smithfield failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
