

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On July 19, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Ralph's Bonded Service (Ralph's) may appeal a July 5, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency modified the high priority corrective action plan and proposed budget for the plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 103 North Franklin in Plymouth, Hancock County. The Board extends the appeal period until November 7, 2002, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000) *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Ralph's fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
