

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 6, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until September 16, 2002, the time period within which Shearon, Inc. (Shearon) may appeal a May 14, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000) *as amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied part of Shearon's request for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund regarding a leaking underground storage tank at 101 Ratloff Street in Harvard, McHenry County. Because Shearon failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
