ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

On July 8, 1986, Electric filed a "motion to continue" this permit appeal proceeding, which is in essence a request for stay of further proceedings until September 1, 1986. The purpose of the stay is to allow time for public comment concerning, and Agency issuance of, a revised NPDES permit which would resolve all disputed issues in this proceeding. Upon issuance of the permit, Electric asserts that a joint motion to dismiss would then be filed. The Board notes that the permit could then become effective as of the date of dismissal of this action.

This action is stayed through September 1, 1986. If no motion to dismiss has been filed by then, the parties are ordered to file a status report on that date.
