ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon a December 10, 1985 petition for variance filed on behalf of the City of Mendota. The Board finds the petition deficient in several areas. Specifically, the City of Mendota should submit more information on the composition of the discharge from its wastewater treatment plant, the identity of the waterway into which such discharge flows, how the City of Mendota will come into compliance with Board regulations and at what cost and the availability of alternative methods of compliance and the associated costs.

Unless this information is filed within 45 days of this Order, this proceeding is subject to dismissal.
