ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.D Dumelle):


This matter comes before the Board upon a December 30, 1985 Petition for Variance filed on behalf of Hansen-Sterling Drum Co. The Board finds that the petition is deficient in several areas.

Specifically, Hansen-Sterling Drum Co. should submit more information on whether it requests a hearing or waives a hearing in this proceeding. If Hansen-Sterling chooses to waive hearing, then it must submit an affidavit attesting to the facts asserted in the petition. Also, the record of this proceeding is deficient in that the record of the prior variance, PCB 83-240, has not been incorporated into this proceeding pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.123.

Unless this additional information is filed within 45 days of this order, this proceeding is subject to dismissal.
