This matter comes before the Board upon an October 21, 1985 Illinois Department of Transportation request for approval of a permit for Wilmette Park District to enable Wilmette to place 8,700 cubic yards of sand for beach nourishment in Lake Michigan, with periodic renourishment as needed at Langdon Park, Wilmette.

The Board requests that Wilmette Park District submit more information regarding the legal authority of the Board to grant a permit in perpetuity and the composition of the sand and any associated contaminants to be placed as beach nourishment.

Unless this additional information is filed with the Board within 45 days of this Order, this proceeding is subject to dismissal.
