ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On May 30, 1985, the Board noted no activity in this case for over a year and ordered the parties to file status reports within 30 days. As no status reports had been filed by August 1, 1985, the Board dismissed this action.

On August 20, 1985, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") filed a motion to Vacate the Dismissal Order, citing that the Agency had never received the Order requiring a status report, possibly due to a move in the Attorney General's office location.

The Board grants the motion. The August 1, 1985, Order is vacated and this matter is reinstated.

The parties are directed to file, not later than November 1, 1985, a status report outlining any anticipated schedule for settlement and any method the Board might use to expedite resolution of this extremely old case.
