On November 12, 1985, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Agency") filed a motion to strike certain language contained in the Department of Energy and Natural Resources' ("DENR") letter of negative declaration from the merit record in this proceeding. That motion is denied. The Board is aware of the Agency's concerns and has addressed this issue in previous Board and Hearing Officer orders (Board Order of July 11, 1985; Hearing Officer Order of September 16, 1985). Additionally, hearing has been scheduled in order to further develop the record in this area.

The Board, therefore, denies the Agency motion to strike and will address the issue after the close of the merit record.
