ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On July 25, 1983, the parties in this case filed a Stipulation to Certain Facts and Agreement for Conduct of Engineering Study, wherein the Agency agreed to delay prosecution of this action pending the outcome of an engineering study performed by an independent engineering firm retained by Marathon. By the terms of the stipulation, the study was to be completed "on or before March 31, 1984, or within six months after Board approval of this stipulation, whichever ever occurs first." There has been no activity in this matter since the filing of this stipulation. If no hearing is scheduled within 30 days and held within 60 days of the date of this order, this case will be subject to dismissal.
