ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On February 11, 1985, the Village of Wataga ("Wataga") filed a petition for variance from the fluoride standard for drinking water (35 Ill. Adm. Code 604.202). That petition is deficient in that it fails to provide information on the following:

- Wataga must incorporate the record of the existing variance and provide an update of any relevant information that has come into existance subsequent to that proceeding.
- 2. Wataga must provide an assessment, with supporting factual information, of the environmental impact that the variance will impose on human health in the affected area.
- 3. A plan for ultimate compliance with the Board's fluoride standards.
- 4. An affidavit that must accompany a statement waiving hearing, in accordance with 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.124.

Unless an amended petition is filed within 45 days curing the above-noted defects, this matter will be subject to dismissal. We also encourage Wataga to utilize the variance petition format found in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121 for future pleadings before the Board.
