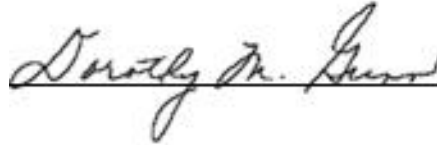
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):
