The Director points out that "wherever the published rules refer to "pico curies per milliliter', they should be corrected by referring to 'micro curies per milliliter'. This error occurs in the tables in Appendix A -- 'Concentrations in Air Above Natural Background' and again in 3.c.".

Since the Board had intended to adopt these rules as proposed by the DNS, the Board hereby orders that those changes be made to the First Notice Order.
