ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On September 27, 1984, Celotex filed a Motion for Continuance of Hearing requesting that the hearing scheduled for October 22, 1984, be continued until 30 days after completion of discovery. The Attorney General filed a response and supplemental response requesting that hearing be held 90 days from the currently scheduled hearing date.

Hearing shall be held in this matter no later than December 22, 1984. This 60 day extension will provide the parties with sufficient time to complete discovery and prepare for hearing. This case has proceeded at an inexcusably slow pace.
