PROPOSED RULE. SECOND NOTICE.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

In its Proposed Opinion and Order of August 2, 1984 the Board proposed to adopt a new rule, 35 <u>Ill. Adm. Code</u> 901.114. First notice of this proposal was published at 8 <u>Ill. Reg.</u> 15274, on August 24, 1984. The first notice comment period expired on October 8, 1984. The Administrative Code Unit submitted a comment on September 10, 1984 concerning Illinois Register first notice format. No other comments have been received. The Board has made a non-substantive change in the wording of the proposed rule.

Section 901.114 Moline Forge Operational Level

Moline Forge and future owners of the forging facility located at 4101 Fourth Avenue, Moline, Illinois, shall comply with the following site-specific operational level:

- a) Operate no more than nine forging hammers at any one time; and
- b) Operate its forging hammers only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 6:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. on Saturdays.
