ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On April 26, 1984 Villa Grove Farmers Elevator Company filed a Petition for Variance from Rule 203(d)(8)(B)(ii), Air Pollution, now codified as 35 Ill. Adm. Code Chapter I, § 212.462(b). This matter will be set for hearing. In order to allow the Board to make an informed decision the parties are encouraged to provide information on the following areas at the hearing:

- 1. Any available estimates of the quantity and type of particulate matter emitted from the dump pit operation.
- 2. Any available estimates of the environmental impact that a variance will impose on human, plant, and animal life in the affected area. Factual supporting information should be included to the extent available.
- 3. Any available information on methods of compliance and any schedule for implementing this plan.

In the event that this variance is granted it may be necessary to include it as a revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for Air Pollution, consequently a hearing must be held.
