ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. Forcade):

On July 9, 1984 the Army Corps filed a petition to extend a previously granted variance. That petition specifically incorporated the May 1, 1984 filing of the Army Corps in PCB 83-25 to satisfy requirements for contents of a petition. The conclusions on environmental impact in the May 1, 1984 filing in PCB 83-25 are based on reference documents that were not included in the filing. Therefore, the May 1, filing, and consequently the July 9, petition are deficient. Unless an amended petition is filed within 45 days curing this defect this matter will be subject to dismissal. The specific references are:

- 1. The six references listed on page 59 of the May 1, 1984 filing in PCB 83-25.
- 2. The eleven references on page 3 of the April 5, 1984 letter from Gary King, IEPA, to Ms. Bernadine Feller McGuire, of Army Corps, contained in the May 1, 1984 filing in PCB 83-25.

If copies of these documents are in short supply, the Army Corps need only file one copy of each listed reference. That filing should be under docket number PCB 84-86.
