ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon a March 23, 1984, petition for variance filed on behalf of the Stauffer Chemical Company (Stauffer). This petition was filed on the same day that it filed a petition for a site-specific sulfur dioxide limitation applicable to its Chicago Heights plant. Variance is requested "until such time as Stauffer's petition for a site-specific mass emission limit for sulfur dioxide ... is granted by the Board."

The Board has today adopted a site-specific sulfur dioxide emission limitation applicable to the plant at issue in this matter (see PCB 84-36). The variance request has, therefore, become moot, and proceedings in this matter are hereby dismissed.
