

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On October 25, 2002, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Freedom Oil Company (Freedom) may appeal a September 17, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency denied Freedom's request for extensions of early action reimbursement and the deadline for the 45-day report regarding a leaking underground storage tank site at 401 South Main Street in Paris, Edgar County. The Board extends the appeal period until January 21, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2000), *amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Freedom fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
