PROPOSED RULE. FIRST NOTICE.

PROPOSED ORDER OF THE BOARD (by W. J. Nega):

The Board hereby adds a new § 304.208 to Subpart B of Part 304 of Title 35 of the Illinois Administrative Code which shall read as follows:

Section 304.208 <u>Discharges From Publicly Owned Treatment</u> Works Into Deep Run Creek in Will County.

- a. This section applies only to discharges from the City of Lockport's sewage treatment plant into Deep Run Creek in Will County, Illinois.
- b. The provisions of § 304.120 shall not apply to said discharge, provided that said discharge shall not exceed 20 mg/1 BOD or 25 mg/1 TSS.
