Proposed Rule. Second Notice.

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

In its Proposed Opinion and Order of October 6, 1983, the Board proposed to adopt a new rule, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.206. First notice of this proposal was published at 7 Ill. Reg. 14910, November 14, 1983, the first notice comment period therefore ending December 28, 1983. The Administrative Code Unit submitted a comment on November 21, 1983, concerning Illinois Register first notice format and noting a typographical error in the rule. The Agency submitted a comment on January 3, 1984, which late submittal is accepted in light of usual holiday-related problems.

The thrust of the Agency's comment is that it "has no objection to the rule proposed by the Board [but] is concerned with the sweeping language of the Board's resolution of the Agency's earlier comments [in the Board's Proposed Opinion of October 6, 1983]" (PC 2, p.1). In the interests of administrative economy, the Board will defer consideration of any amendment of its Proposed Opinion until adoption of a Final Opinion and Order in this matter. The Board therefore directs that second notice of the following rule be submitted to the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules:

Section 304.206Alton Water Company Treatment Plant DischargesThis Section applies to the existing 18.3 million gallons per daypotable drinking water treatment plant owned by the Alton Water

Company which is located at, and discharges into, river mile 204.4 on the Mississippi River. Such discharges shall not be subject to the effluent standards for total suspended solids and total iron of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.124.
